PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING

LEGITIMATION FOR DATA PROCESSING

The data obtained shall be sorted for the time required to respond to the given request(s).

RECIPIENTS OF YOUR DATA

Your data will not be provided to third parties and will be processed with strict confidentiality and in accordance with the security measures as established in current legislation or as required by a specific law, if applicable.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

Persons whose data is processed by FICPI are entitled, at any time, to access their data, rectify it, object to its being processed or have it deleted if such persons believe that the data is no longer required for the purposes for which it was collected.

Also, such a person may request a limitation concerning the processing of his/her data in which case FICPI will only store the data required to make claims or defend the Federation against claims. Such persons may also, at any time, revoke the consent given.
